## Guidelines for Care Choir Session approved 5/4/21

According to the *Long Beach Safer At Home Order for Control of COVID-19* (4/16/21), Long Beach is now in the Orange Tier (moderate COVID-19 spread).

Following the 4/16/21 Long Beach Safer At Home Order and the 7/29/20 California Industry Guidance: places of worship and providers of religious services and cultural ceremonies, outdoor services are strongly encouraged and indoor services are strongly recommended to remain at 50% capacity with certain modifications. Please follow guidance from the city and state for more complete information.

Back office staff and management may operate indoors and in-person according the *Office Worksite Protocol*. Masks must be worn and a physical distance of 6 ft must be maintained. Please refer to the *Faithful Phasing* document and the Long Beach *Office Worksite Protocol* for complete guidelines.

The Reopening Team recommends permitting the Care Choir to return to its ministry to share Christ's love with the community, following the guidelines of the *Faithful Phasing* document, as is appropriate, and the Long Beach *Safer At Home Order* (4/16/21).

## **Preparation**

- 1. All in-person visits are at the discretion of the Care Choir and with the parishioner's permission.
- 2. Care Choir members and the visited parishioner must sign COVID-19 release forms.
- 3. The Care Choir leader must attend a COVID-19 training session, provided by Chris Chandler.
- 4. For added safety, vaccinations of all participants is encouraged.
- 5. Care Choir members will be health screened (checked for signs and symptoms) before they visit.
- 6. Parishioners will also be health screened by the Choir leader upon arrival.
- 7. Care Choir members must check in at the church with Chris Chandler, sign the attendance sheet, do a temperature scan, and document when/where they go.

## Visitation

- 8. Singers must wear a face covering (mask, or mask and shield).
- 9. In order to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19 through aerosol droplets, singing will take place outdoors, while maintaining a minimum of 6 ft physical distance, masked.
- 10. The number of singers should be kept low. Limit the time you spend at each visitation.
