

Concert Guidelines

According to the Long Beach Safer at Home Order of COVID-19 (8/13/20), “live entertainment, including, but not limited to, live music and live performances”, is not permitted at this time. It does not specifically prohibit live-streamed concerts with no audience present.

The Reopening Team recommends permitting live-streamed concerts with no audience present under the following circumstances:

1. Inside concerts will be live-streamed with no live audience present.
2. Inside concerts may not interfere with scheduled live-streamed worship services.
3. A liability waiver must be signed by all musicians and others involved in the concert.
4. A maximum of 10 persons may be in the room (musicians, technicians, others).
5. All musicians, technicians, and others must comply with GFPC All Campus Guidelines, wear a mask, keep a minimum of 6’ physical distance from each other, and wash hands regularly.
6. Inside concerts will allow for proper ventilation after the event. There should be a complete replacement of air inside the room with air from the outside.
7. Singing solo or in small groups is allowed. Instruments such as percussions, strings, keyboards, and bells are permitted. Instruments that you blow into are discouraged. If they are used, it is recommended they have cloth instrument covers to limit aerosol emissions. Wind instrument musicians must face in the same direction when playing.
8. All musicians must keep a minimum of 6 feet physical distance from each other when performing. All musicians, with the exception of singers and wind instrument musician, must wear a mask when performing.
9. The rooms that are used will be completely sanitized after occupancy (includes restrooms).
10. There will be no food or beverages served. Individuals may bring their own water in a covered container.

This policy may be updated from time to time as is appropriate.
